DIPLOMA IN NEW MEDIA DESIGN

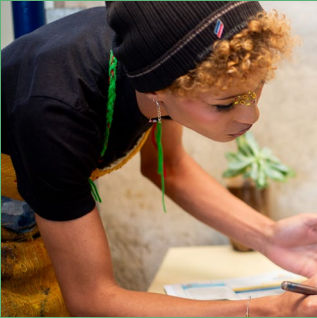
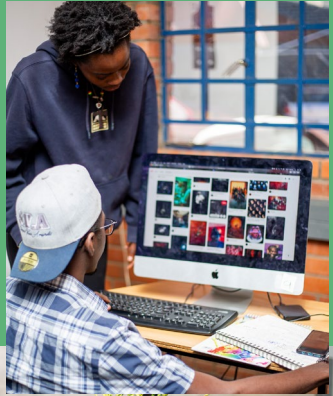

NEW MEDIA DESIGN:

- A grade 10 or 12 academic report/ 17 points with a D in English
- A desirable work portfolio **or**
- Mature age (23 years or older) with 3 years of experience and undergo a personal interview.
